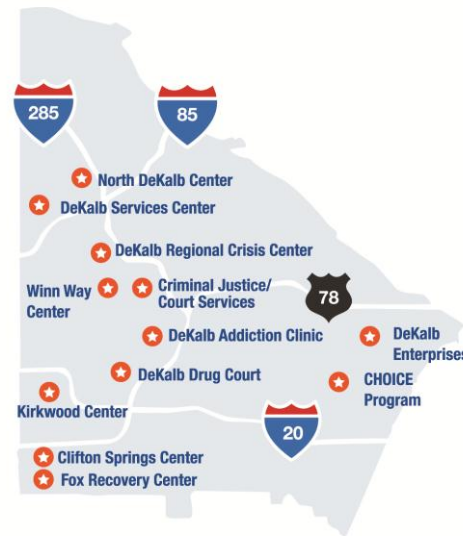
## PROGRAMS & SERVICES
