WHO WE ARE: The DeKalb Community Service Board (CSB) is a public, non-profit provider of mental health, developmental disabilities, and addiction diseases services to citizens of DeKalb County, Georgia. With over 20 locations, including outpatient clinics, the DeKalb Regional Crisis Center, the DeKalb Addiction Clinic, the DeKalb MR Services Center, DeKalb Enterprises, CHOICE and Crossroads programs, the DeKalb CSB provides quality, person-centered services with a focus on recovery and helping consumers achieve their fullest participation within the community. The DeKalb CSB is accredited by CARF (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities).

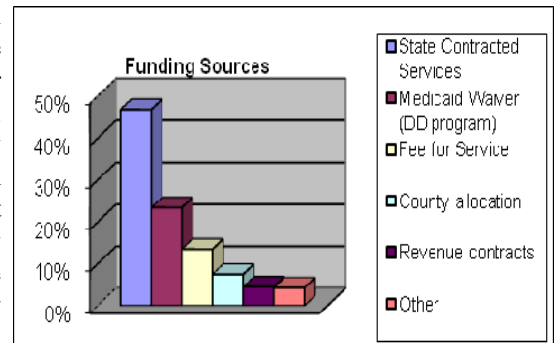
MISSION & VISION: The DeKalb Community Service Board strives to provide the right service, for the right person, at the right time and envisions a community in which disabilities no longer limit potential.

STAFFING: Over 475 dedicated and qualified staff members represent the DeKalb CSB including social service providers, service coordinators, behavioral specialists, registered nurses, physicians, psychiatrists, psychologists and administrative support: para-professionals, clerical employees, and technical and service staff.

FUNDING: The DeKalb CSB charges for services based on income and family size, utilizing a sliding-fee scale for eligible consumers. Revenues for fiscal year 2009 totaled \$29 million. In addition to fee revenue, the agency receives funding from DeKalb County and the Georgia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities. Over the past eight years, state funding for services in DeKalb County has declined by over 36 percent. 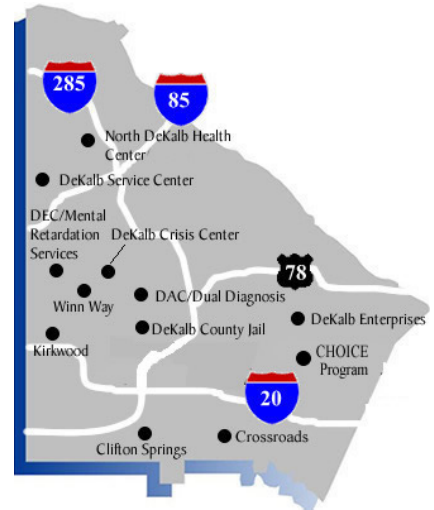
