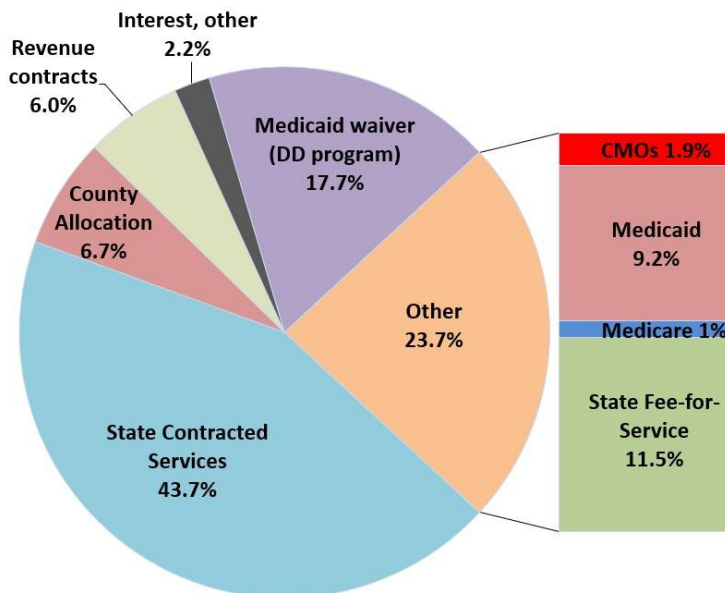
MISSION & VISION
